## **2021 Community Grants**

City of Newcastle's (CN) Grants and Sponsorships programs have been modernised following stakeholder engagement to deliver better outcomes for the community. The new Policies, exhibited from 24 February to 24 March 2021, were adopted on 27 April 2021.

The Community Support Grant Funding Round opened from 3-31 May 2021. Under the Community Grants Program a total of 94 applications were received requesting a total of \$1,060,235 in funding. Funding for 59 projects totalling \$457,121 was awarded.
