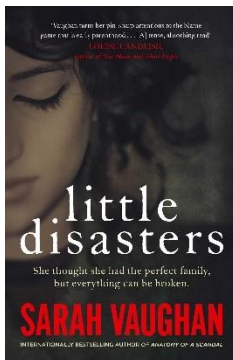


## Little disasters by Sarah Vaughan
