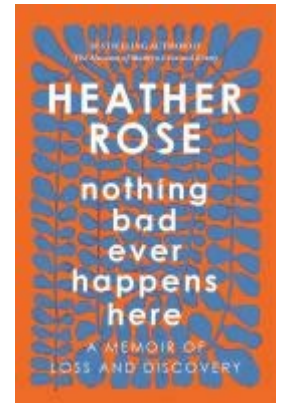


Nothing bad ever happens here by Heather Rose
