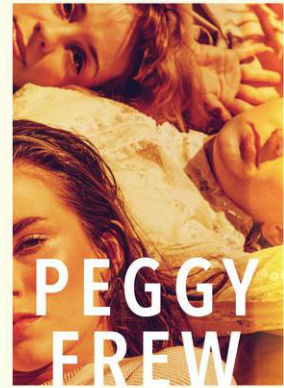


Wildflowers by Peggy Frew
