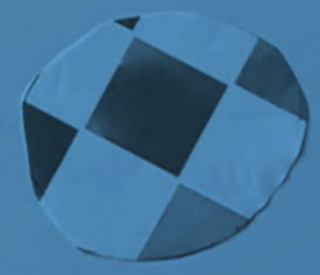

Krazy Kookaburra

What you need

- 1 x A4 sheet of paper or card (old cereal box is a good substitute)
- Pencils/textas for colouring
- Glue
- Optional – old magazines for collage and gum leaves to decorate.

What to do

- Print off or trace the template sheet
- Colour in, or decorate all pieces with collage, then cut out
- Colour both sides of the insert piece the same colour as the colour of the wings that it will attach to
- Form a cylinder shape from the kookaburra body and glue into place.
- Fold the beak along the fold lines, and glue together
- Glue eyes, beak and wings into place on the body
- On the insert cut along the solid line, then fold in half.
- Glue the uncut section of the insert together, leaving the cut section in 2 parts.
- Feed the insert into the centre of the kookaburra, single end to the base and the split end up behind the head.
- Glue each of the insert ends to each of the wings to flap.
- Glue gum leaves to add extra decoration for tail feathers or head tufts.
- Hold the body of the Kookaburra, and pull up and down on the insert at the base to see your kookaburra flap.



Kookaburra facts

- Kookaburras are the largest bird in the kingfisher family
- There are four types of kookaburras
 - Rufous-Bellied Kookaburra
 - Spangled Kookaburra
 - Blue-Winged Kookaburra
 - Laughing Kookaburra
- Laughing kookaburras are the species of kookaburra most commonly found in the Newcastle area
- Kookaburras are carnivorous, they will eat insects, small mammals, lizards and even venomous snakes.
- Kookaburras laugh to mark and protect their territory
- A group of kookaburras is called a riot. Can you guess why?
