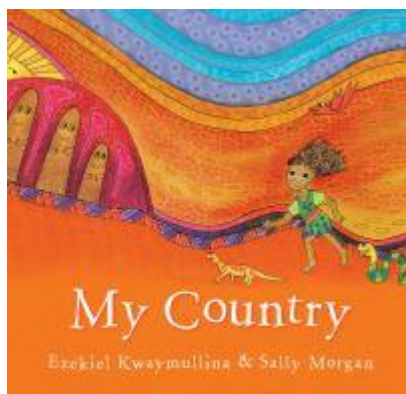

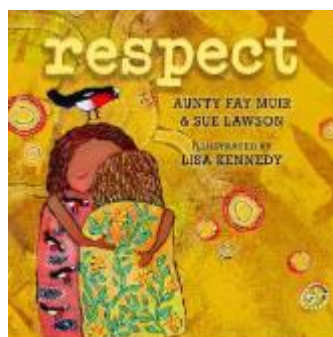
### **My Country** By Ezekiel Kwaymullina

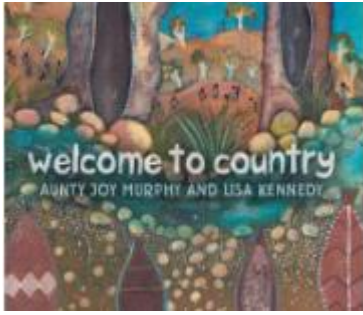


### **Respect** By Auntie Fay Muir and Sue Lawson. Illustrated by Lisa Kennedy.

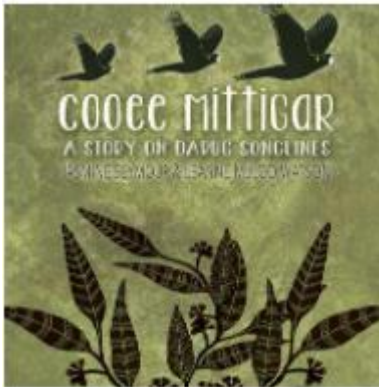


**Welcome to country**

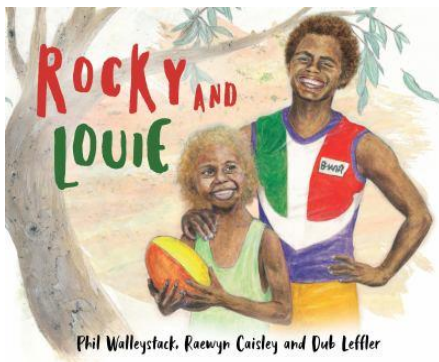


**Cooee Mittigar: A Story on Darug Songlines**

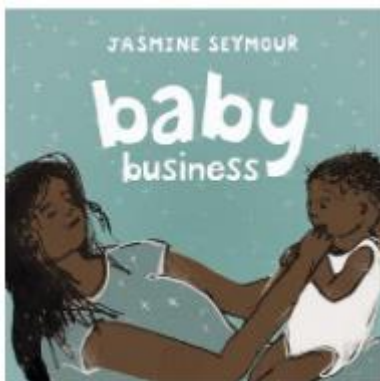


**Rocky and Louie**

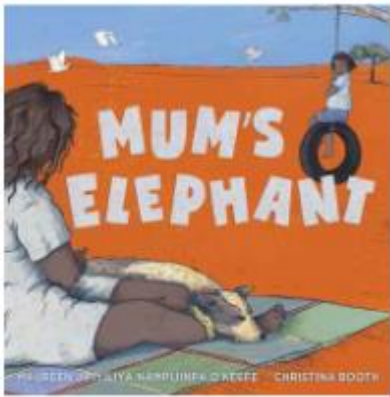


**Baby business**

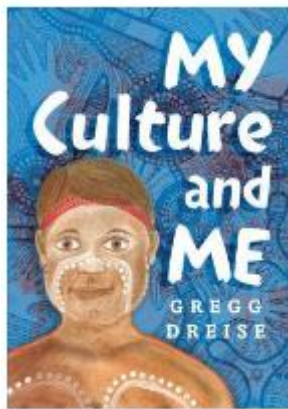


**Coming Home to Country**

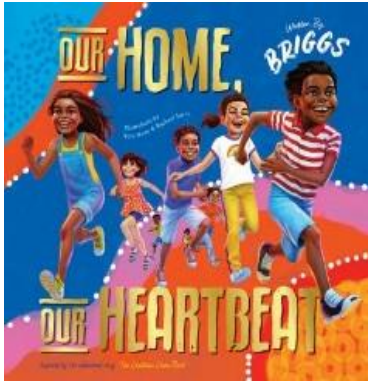


**My culture and me**

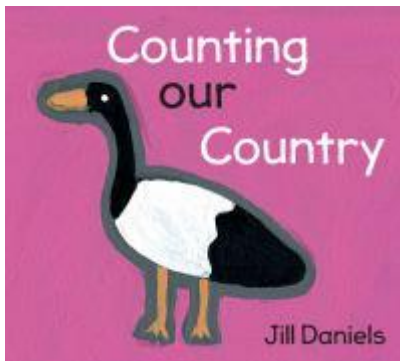


**Our home, our heartbeat**

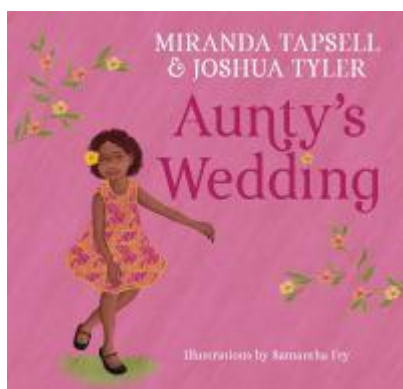


**Counting our Country**
