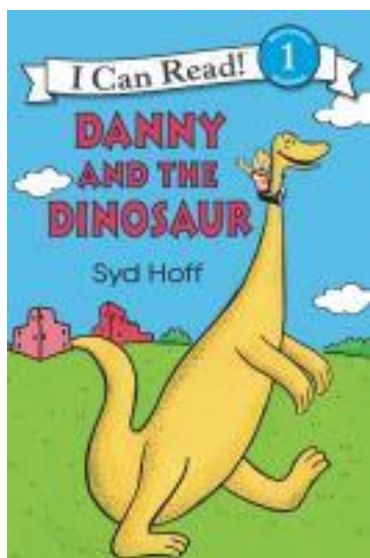


## Dinosaur Books Early readers



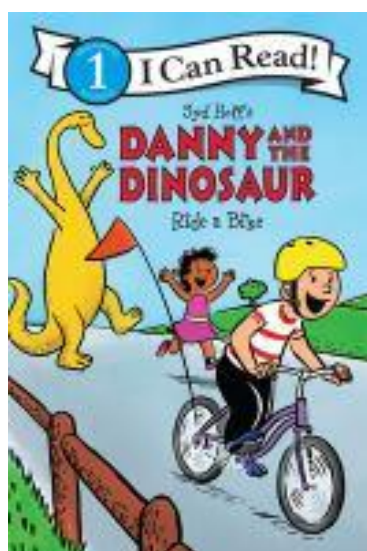
### **Danny and the Dinosaur** By Syd Hoff.

### **Syd Hoff's Danny and the Dinosaur Ride a Bike** By Bruce Hale.

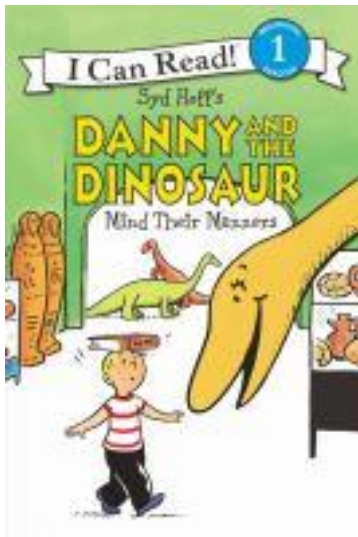

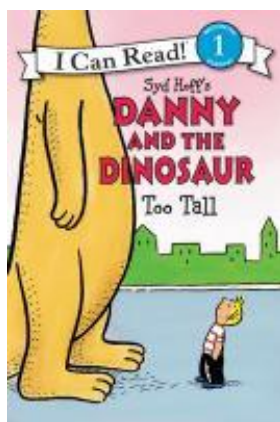


### **Syd Hoff's Danny and the Dinosaur: Mind their Manners By Bruce Hale.**

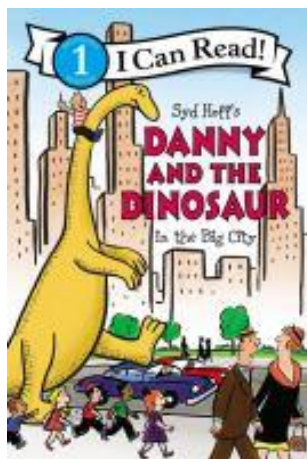


### **Syd Hoff's Danny and the Dinosaur Too Tall By Bruce Hale.**

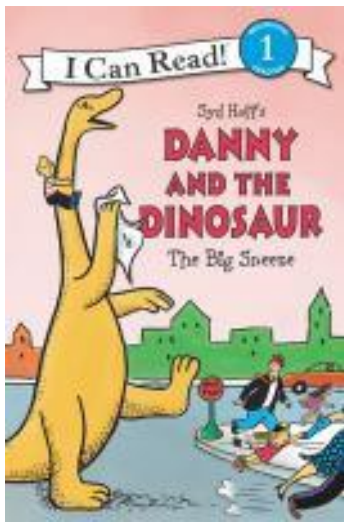
### **Syd Hoff's Danny and the Dinosaur and the Big City By Bruce Hale.**

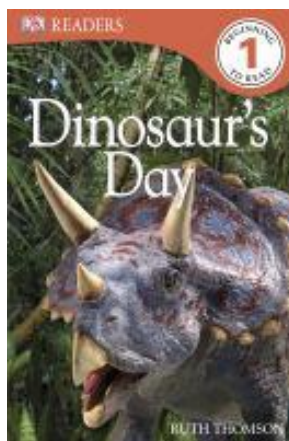


**Max Spaniel: Dinosaur Hunt**

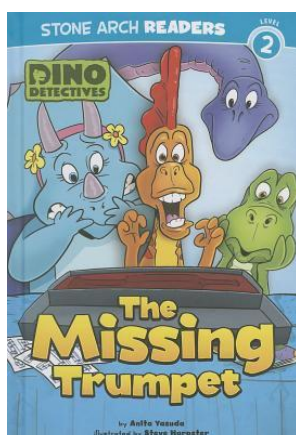


**Dinosaur's Day**

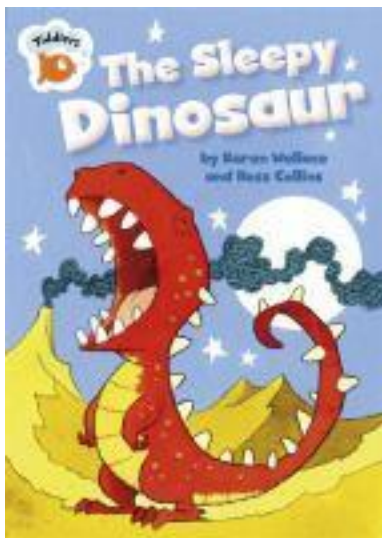


## **Ghost Sounds** **By Anita Yasuda.**

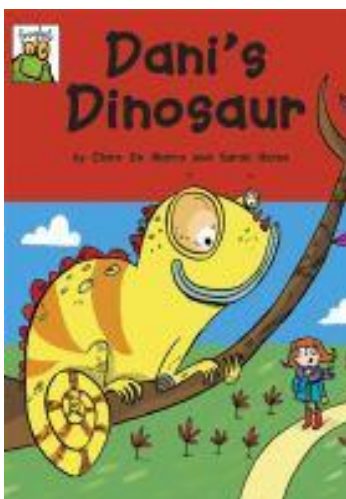


## **The Sleepy Dinosaur** **By Karen Wallace.**

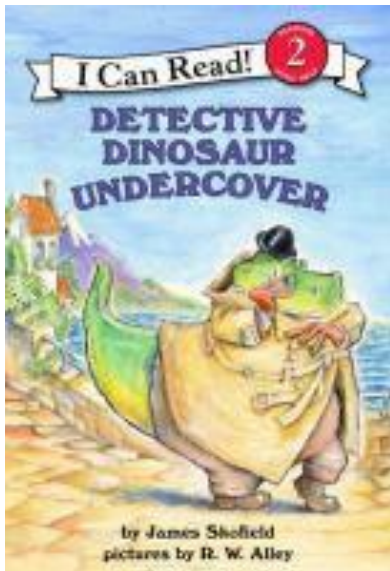


## **Dani's Dinosaur** **By Clare De Marco.**

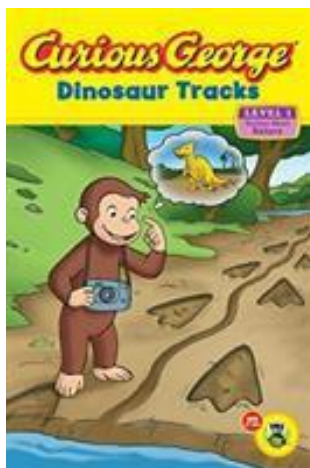


## **Dinosaur Detective Undercover By James Skofield.**

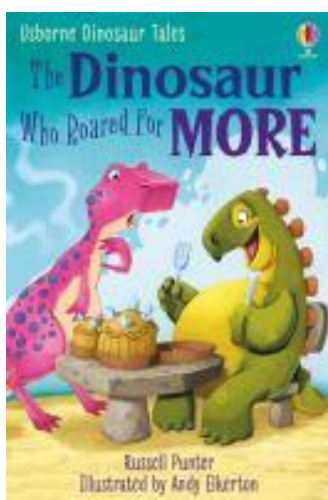


## **Curious George: Dinosaur Tracks By Julie Tibbott.**

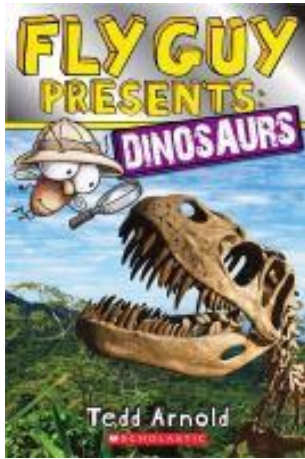


## **Dinosaur who Roared for More By Russell Punter.**

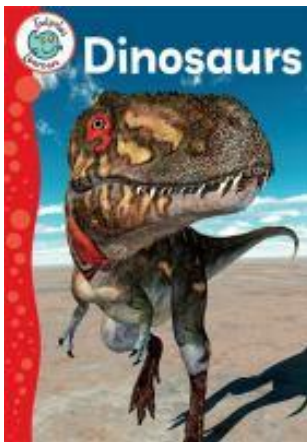


### **Fly Guy presents: Dinosaurs By Todd Arnold.**

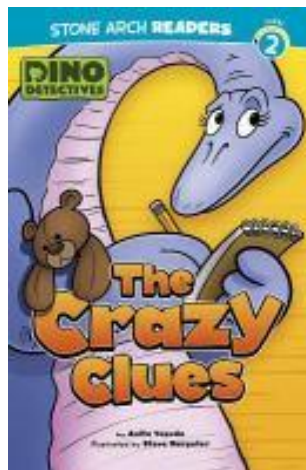

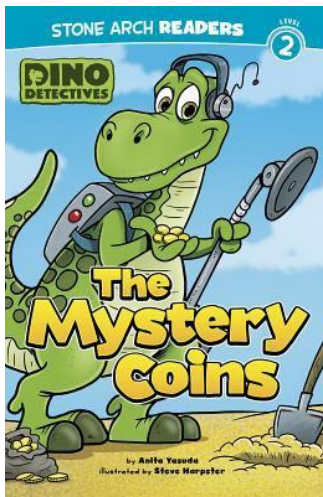

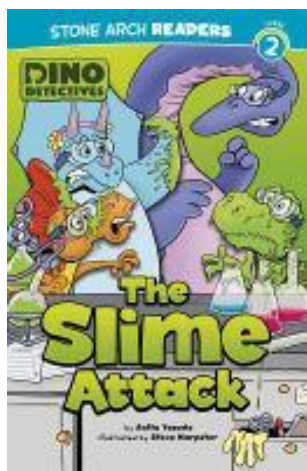


## **The Mystery Coins By Anita Yasuda.**

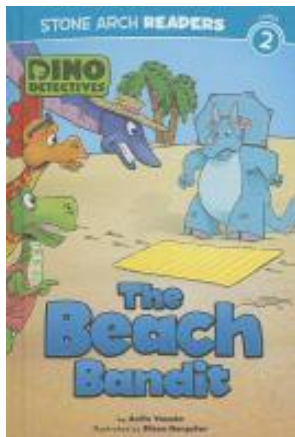

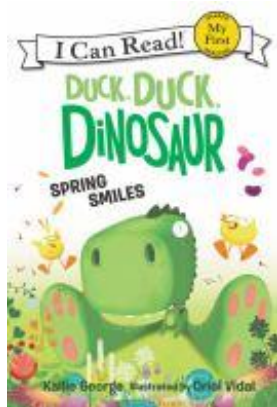
