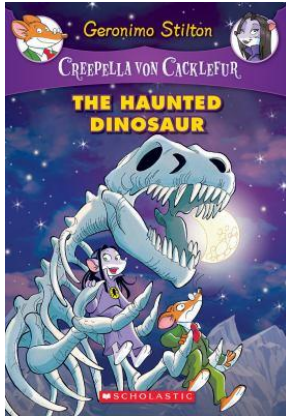
Jurassis World: Fallen Kingdom By David Lewman.

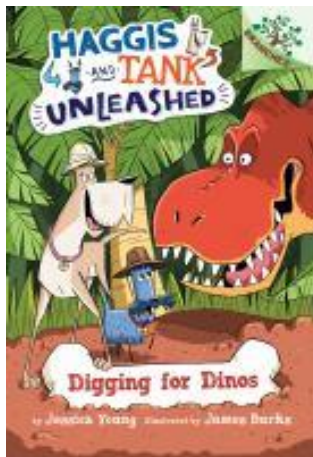


Creepella von Cracklefur: The Haunted Dinosaur By Geronimo Stilton.

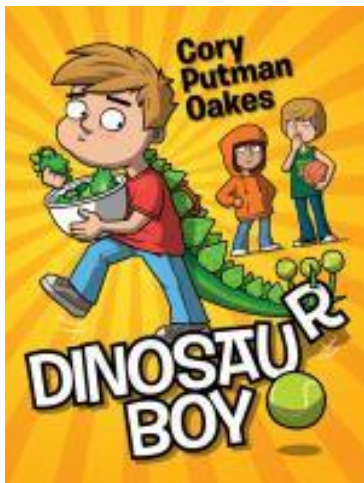


Digging for Dinos By Jessica Young.

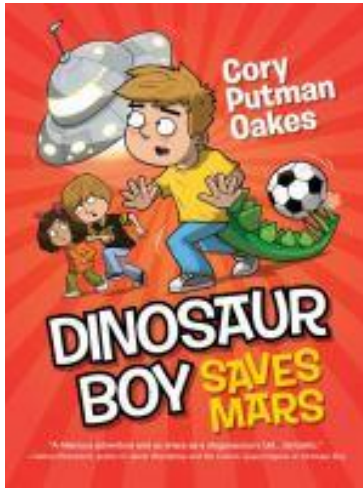


Dinosaur Boy By Cory Putman Oakes.

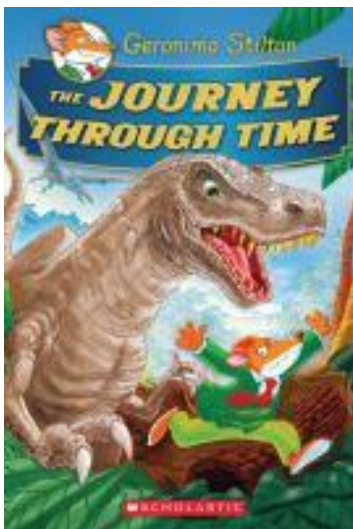


Battlesaurus: Rampage at Waterloo **By Marion Cocklico**

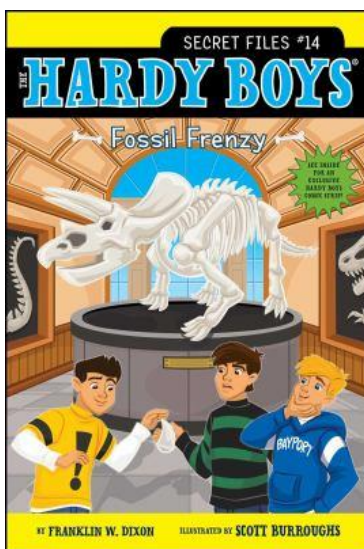


Deadly Drama **By Steve Cole.**

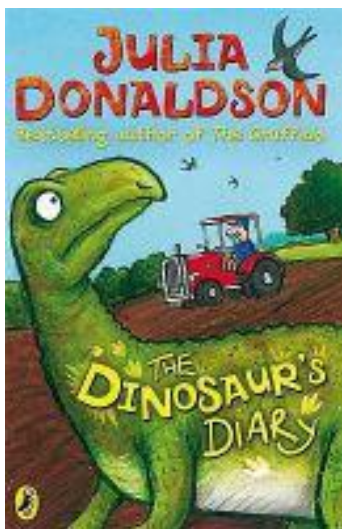

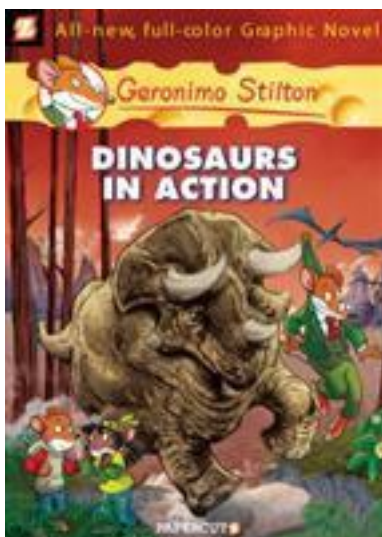


The Dinosaurs Diary **By Julia Donaldson.**

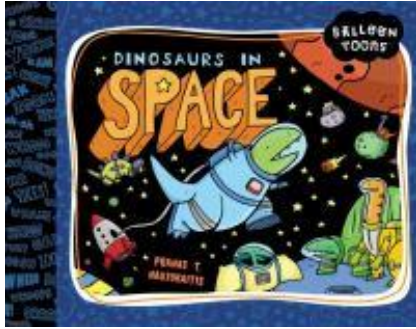


Dinosaurs in Action **By Geronimo Stilton.**
