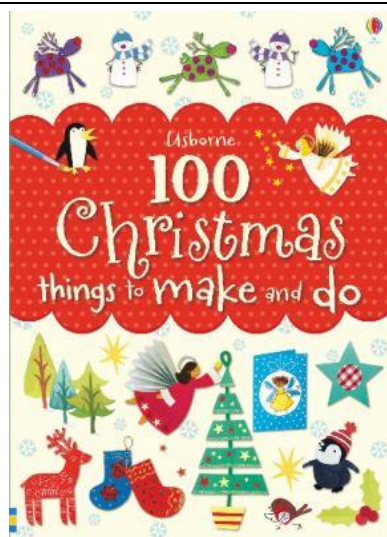

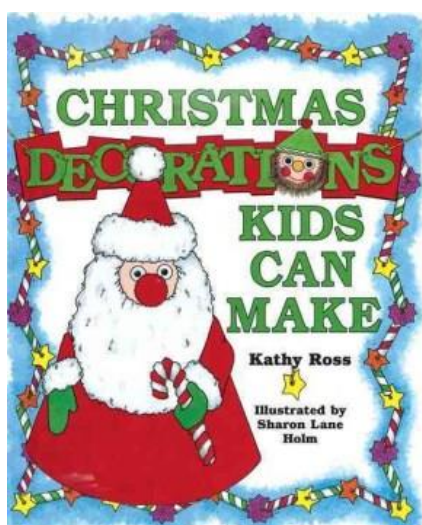


100 Christmas Things to make and do **By Fiona Watt.**

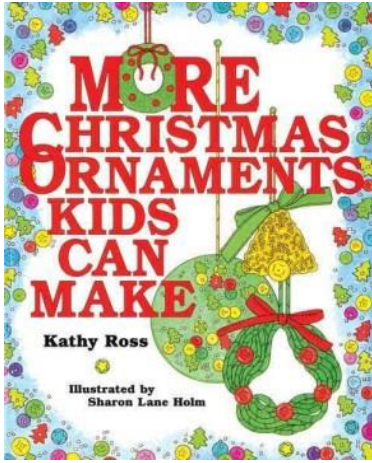


Christmas Decorations Kids can make **By Cathy Ross.**

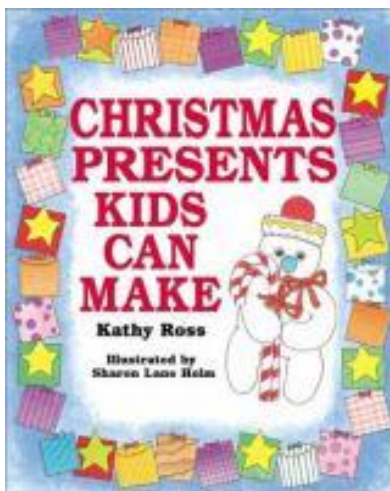

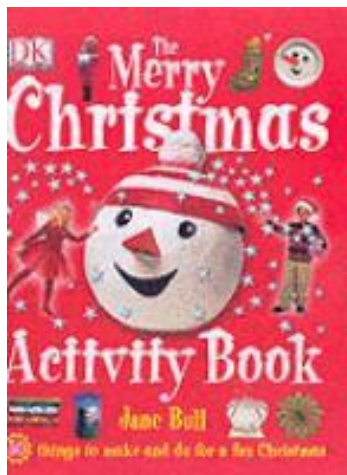


My Christmas Art Class By Nellie Shepherd.

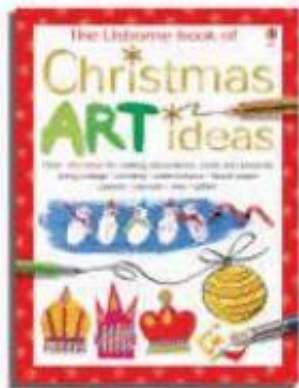

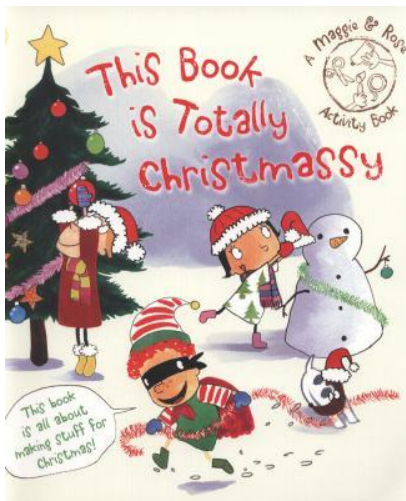

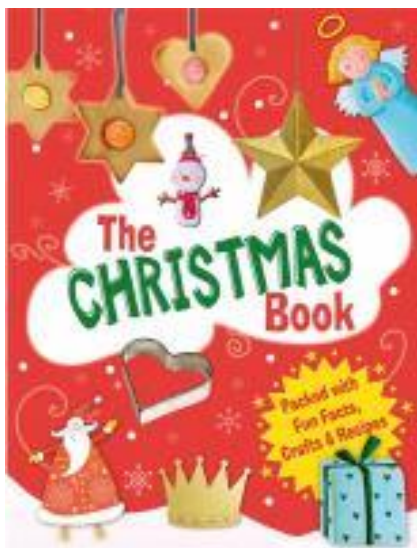
