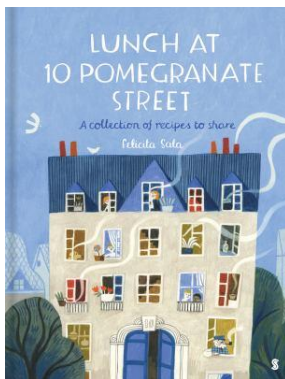


Lunch at 10 Pomegranate Street
