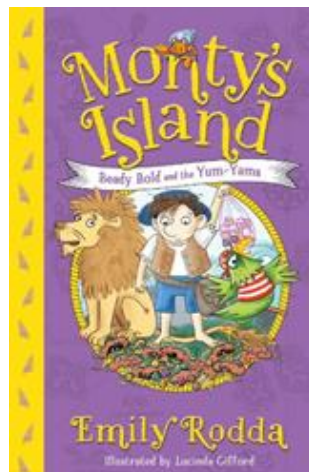
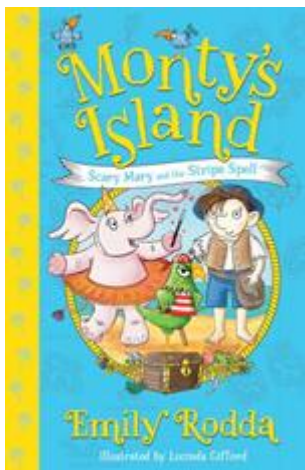


Monty's Island

How will Monty and the gang trick Scary Mary and stop her from fulfilling her plan. The second book Beady Bold and the yum yams again presents an even bigger challenge for the friends to solve. Teamwork and fast thinking will save the day.

The story is full of excitement and adventure, with some humour rolled in. I think that once discovered, kids will want to keep reading all the books in the series. Can't wait for the next adventure coming out in early 2021.
