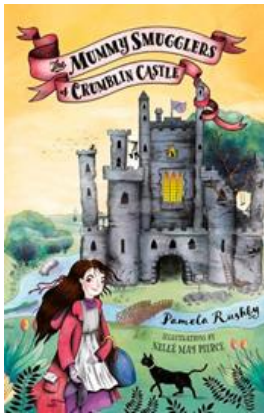


The Mummy Smugglers of Crumblin Castle
