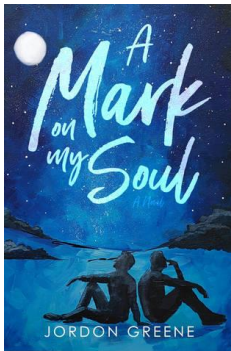


## A Mark on my soul by Jordon Greene
