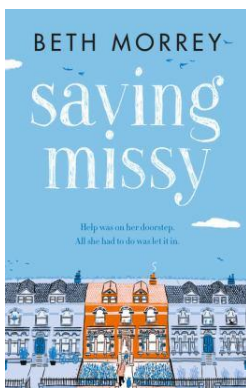


Saving Missy by Beth Morrey
