## **Associated traffic changes:**

Temporary closure of Nash Street and Cameron Street intersection at Wallsend.

## **Commencing from:**

28 November 2024

We will soon be implementing changes to the intersection of Nash Street and Cameron Street to improve access to Wallsend Health Campus, as well as traffic flow through to the Cameron Street and Minmi Road intersection.

We anticipate completing this section of work by January 2025, depending on weather conditions.

There will be temporary changes to vehicle and pedestrian access in and around our site. The work will involve machinery that generates noise. We will make every effort to minimise the impact of this noise and ensure that noisy activities do not start before 7am. Access to the southern portion of Nash Street and the Wallsend Health Campus will remain open via Longworth Avenue into Bean Street, unless we communicate otherwise.

Works include (refer to the map on page over):

- Temporary road closure of Nash Street between Cameron Street and Bean Street
- Construction of new connection of Nash Street and Stapleton Street
- Construction of new stormwater drainage, shared pathways and footpaths
- Construction of new shared path crossing of Nash Street and Cameron Street intersection.
