

SELECTION CRITERIA

PURPOSE OF THE INFRASTRUCTURE ADVISORY COMMITTEE

To provide advice and guidance on the development of strategies, and identification of challenges and opportunities, in relation to built and natural facilities and systems within the LGA, including coastal revitalisation programs, building and facility upgrades, environmental matters including coastal and floodplain management, stormwater, transport and cycleways delivery.

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1. Professional experience in one or more of the following – civil engineering, infrastructure management, planning for integrated public and active transport services, environmental management or related fields.
2. Demonstrated interest and understanding of planning programs for improved community outcomes.
3. Experience in evaluating infrastructure management options to achieve triple bottom line outcomes.

Applicants must submit a statement of no more than two pages outlining how they meet the selection criteria and how this relates to the purpose of the committee.
