

SELECTION CRITERIA

PURPOSE OF THE STRATEGY AND INNOVATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE

To provide advice and guidance on the development and implementation of strategies, and identification of challenges and opportunities, in relation to the economic development and diversification of Newcastle as destination leading in innovative technologies, smart infrastructure, high value investment, and major events and tourism.

Continue the implementation of strategies and advocacy emanating from the Lord Mayor's City Taskforce in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, to ensure the City's continued economic recovery.

SELECTION CRITERIA

1. Experience in one more areas related to smart infrastructure, technology and/or innovation; economic development and diversification; tourism, destination management and major events.
2. Experience in guiding the development of policies and strategies in relation to the management of smart infrastructure, major events and tourism, economic development including the night time economy, to provide optimal community outcomes.
3. Membership and active involvement in a group, network or organisation with a relevant interest.

Applicants must submit a statement of no more than two pages outlining how they meet the selection criteria and how this relates to the purpose of the committee.
