## Exhibition

City of Newcastle is proposing a road name for one (1) existing public road in Wallsend.

This road needs to be named to facilitate address numbering and to aid emergency service wayfinding and service delivery to properties fronting the road. The road is unofficially known as Brickworks Lane and provides access to several properties that front the road. This proposal seeks to formalise this road name. The proposed name has been supported by the NSW Geographical Names Board (GNB). Members of the community are now invited to view and make comment on the proposed road name.

Proposed Road Name	Suburb	Name Origin	Road Extent Description
Brickworks Lane	Wallsend	The road is named for its proximity to the former site of the Wallsend Brickworks, which operated from 1891 to 1977.	The road begins at its intersection with Newcastle Road and continues in a southern direction for 115 metres before coming to an end.

- quote 'Wallsend Road Naming - June 2024' in the title of the submission.
- include the submitter's name, address, and daytime contact number; and
- where possible, an email address.

**Please note:** Submissions will only be considered that directly relate to the proposed road names.
