

Works update

Upgrade of Bathers Way, South Newcastle Beach

We are creating a vibrant and attractive hub for visitors and residents while upgrading the pedestrian and cycle path links in this section of Bathers Way at South Newcastle Beach.

Now that we are in the final stages of delivery our contractor, Daracon, will be completing the widened Bathers Way shared path, the new amenities blocks, seating areas, landscaping and exercise stations.

This may involve work on the weekends and/or at night.

How will the work affect you?

The work will involve truck movements and the use of machinery which generates noise. During infrequent periods of nightworks lighting will also be required. We will make every effort to minimise the impact of these works, and schedule works during daytime as much as possible to minimise disruption.

Changes to traffic

The existing temporary changes near Shortland Esplanade will remain. In addition, construction vehicles will periodically access our work site via King Edward Park.

To ensure the work zone is safe and to minimise the impact of our works, we will have signage in place and workers onsite to manage traffic movements and diversions during our works.

Local business and resident access will remain available at all times unless otherwise communicated directly.
