# A snapshot of people with lived experience of disability in Newcastle



# Estimates of the number of people living with disability



#### People with profound or severe disability in Newcastle LGA in 2021<sup>1</sup>:

- 10,752 people (or 6.4% of the population) had a 'profound or severe disability, defined as people "needing help or assistance in one or more of the three core activity areas of self-care, mobility and communication, because of a disability, long term health condition (lasting six months or more) or old age" (NSW = 5.8%)
- An additional 8,289 (4.9% of population) did not state whether or not they had a need for assistance



### The likelihood of living with disability increases with age.

- 31% of 55-64-year olds are living with disability.
- Almost 9 in 10 people aged 90 and over (88%) have a disability

A disability is any condition that restricts a person's mental, sensory or mobility functions. Almost 90% of disabilities are not visible.

17% of the NSW population had a 'reported disability' in 2018<sup>2</sup>, as opposed to 6.4% being recorded as 'requiring assistance' in the 2021 Census- suggesting that the number of people with disability in Newcastle may be higher.


In June 2022<sup>3</sup>, there were

**5,072 people** participating in the National Disability Insurance Scheme (NDIS) in the Newcastle LGA. This has decreased since June 2020, when there were **7,542 people**.

# In Australia in 2018 of people living with disability: 4

- 77% reported a physical disorder as their main condition, the most common being a musculoskeletal disorder (30%)
- **23%** reported a mental or behavioural disorder as their main condition.





# Where do people with disability live?


#### In Newcastle LGA in 20215:

Warabrook SA2 had the highest proportion of people 'needing assistance' (15%) followed by Waratah (12%), Elermore Vale (10%) and Wallsend (9.8%). In total, these 3 areas accounted for 2,762 people.

# Age

#### In Newcastle LGA in 20216:

- 81% of people who required assistance were aged 45 years and over
- 41% were 75 years and over (35% in 2016)
- The largest age bracket was for 85 years and over 52% of total age group
- Only 12% were under 20 years of age, same as in 2016.





#### Income

#### In the Newcastle LGA in 20217:

- Only 16% of people 'requiring assistance' had a weekly personal income of \$650 or more (21% in 2016), compared to 62% of people not requiring assistance
- The most represented income brackets for people 'requiring 'assistance' were between \$300-\$500 per week - at 45%, compared to 14% of people not requiring assistance
- The proportion of people requiring assistance who did not state their income was 11%, compared with only 1% of people not requiring assistance.



# **Employment and labour force participation**

In the Newcastle LGA in 2021, of people over 15 years who needed assistance with core activities8:

- 86% were not in the labour force (28% for people who have no need for assistance)
- **7% were employed** (711 people) (64% for people who had no need for assistance)



## **Education level**

In the Newcastle LGA in 2021, of people who needed assistance with core activities?:

- 25% had a secondary education of Year 9 or below (6% for people who did not require assistance)
- 6% had a Bachelor degree as compared to 4.9% in 2016 (21% for people who did not require
- 2% had a Postgraduate degree (7% for people who did not require assistance)
